For our earthly fathers disciplined us for a few years, doing the best they knew how. But God's discipline is always good for us, so that we might share in his holiness. No discipline is enjoyable while it is happening—it's painful! But afterward there will be a peaceful harvest of right living for those who are trained in this way.

So take a new grip with your tired hands and strengthen your weak knees. Mark out a straight path for your feet so that those who are weak and lame will not fall but become strong.

I Pray that we will not "Assume" on the "Provision" of Father God and understand that His Provision will not always be provided just because we ask for it --- Our Father Knows Best! Our "Ultimate" Reward and Provision was provided on The Cross of Salvation with The Sinless Blood of Christ Jesus and it will be "Revealed" in Its "Totality" when we see Jesus Christ "Face to Face" in His Fathers Kingdom!
